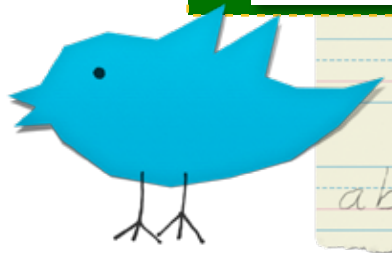


# FREE CHILDCARE AT CLIMATE CYCLE 100

## CLIMATE CYCLE 100 MUSEUM ACTIVITIES

### BUTTERFLY HAVEN

Get up close to more than 75 species of exotic butterflies and stunning bird species from the Southern hemisphere in a 2,700 square-foot greenhouse filled with pools of water, flowers, tropical trees and 1,000 butterflies, including those never-before-seen in our region.

### CRITTERCAM

Watch a great white shark capture its prey, follow penguins glide beneath the ice, and take an ocean voyage with seals through Crittercam. Crittercam is a scientific video- and data-gathering tool safely worn by wild animals, offering researchers insights into animal behavior and clues to protecting animals and the world we share.



### ART ACTIVITY

The children will participate in an art activity related to Climate Cycle activities. The art will be displayed at the end of the evening and on the May ride.
